

Breastmilk Storage Guidelines

AT ROOM TEMPERATURE:

- At 60 degrees for 24 hours
- At 66-72 degrees for 10 hours
- At 79 degrees for 4-6 hours

IN THE REFRIGERATOR:

At 32-39 degrees for up to 8 days

IN THE FREEZER:

- In a self-contained refrigerator freezer for 3-4 months
- In a deep freezer for 6-12 months

NOTES:

- Once frozen milk is thawed, use within 24 hours and do not refreeze.
- Never microwave breastmilk.
- Gently warm in a bowl of warm water or under warm, running tap water.
- Swirl, don't shake.
- Store in glass containers or bags designed for milk storage.
